

Secondary School Uniform Guidelines

Years 12 & 13 Dress Code

Students are not expected wear the Renaissance College uniform, however, they are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to being in school.

Hair colour must be of a natural colour and style without excessive gel, highlights or extensions.

Make-up should not be worn to excess.

No jewellery is to be worn while participating in physical activity and at other times should be of a subtle nature – large hoop or dangling earrings are not permitted at any time.

Years 7-11

Students are expected to dress in an appropriate manner in the Renaissance College uniform, with the RCHK logo.

Uniform should fit appropriately – neither too tight nor too baggy. Skirts should not be too short.

Hair colour must be natural and styled without excessive gel, highlights or extensions.

Make-up should not be worn in excessive amounts.

Shoes must be predominantly black or brown with black, brown or white laces. During winter, ankle-height boots may be worn.

Socks should be black, brown or white and should not be higher than knee- height. During winter plain black tights or leggings may be worn.

No jewellery is to be worn while participating in physical activity and at other times should be of a subtle nature. Facial piercing is not allowed, other than discreet nose-studs.
