About Renaissance College

Renaissance College Hong Kong (RCHK) is a co-educational independent school. RCHK was established in 2006 by the English Schools Foundation (ESF) to serve the needs of the local and international expatriate community in Hong Kong. It is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School and accredited by Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) as well as Council of International Schools (CIS).

Student Body

Renaissance College is home to 2060 students, ranging from Year 1 to Year 13. We have a diverse student body, with 41 nationalities and 21 languages represented on campus. There are more than 1074 students enrolled in the Secondary School, with 283 students currently pursuing the IB Diploma, IB Courses and IBCP Programmes.

Curriculum

Renaissance College is an authorized IB World School offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), the Diploma Programme (DP) and International Baccalaureate Career-Related Programme (IBCP). In Year 12 and 13, students undertake the full IB Diploma Programme, IB Courses or IBCP. Our MYP programme is subject to external monitoring by the IBO.

IB Diploma students enroll in six subjects. They also undertake Theory of Knowledge (ToK), complete a 4,000-word Extended Essay (EE) and participate in a Creativity, Action and Service (CAS) programme.

Students are NOT ranked at Renaissance College. Our first cohort of IB Diploma students graduated in May 2009.

Assessment and Reporting

Formal student assessment is criterion-based. Students receive two full semester reports and one progress report each academic year.

Renaissance College follows the International Baccalaureate seven point grading scale.
 7 = Excellent 6 = Very Good 5 = Good
 4 = Satisfactory 3 = Mediocre 2 = Poor 1 = Very Poor

- Language and Literature: English and Putonghua (Chinese)
- Language Acquisition: Putonghua (Chinese)
- Individuals and Societies (formerly Humanities)
- Sciences
- Mathematics
- Physical and Health Education (formerly Physical Education)
- Design (formerly Design and Technology)
- The Arts: Music, Drama and Visual Art
- Personal Project (Year 11 only)
