



IB Diploma Provisional Results: May 2017 - RC

We are very pleased to announce that we have a 99% pass rate for the IB Diploma Programme (DP) for the May 2017 session. Two of our students gained 44 points which is an exceptional result, along with 42% of our students gaining bilingual diplomas, which is well above the world average of 23%. It is also pleasing to note that we have a 100% pass rate for all those students eligible for a bilingual IB Diploma. Currently, the DP average points total is 35 with an average subject grade of 5.5. Additionally, we expect our averages to increase as the results of remarks come back (approximately 25% year on year come back as upgrades) and it should be noted that the previous year's results are the final statistics after all remarks had been conducted for that session.

The Career-related Programme (CP) results were excellent, with an average IB subject grade of 5.3 across all the IB courses that the students took. We also have out first bilingual CP certificate awarded.






