Dear Year 7 Parents and Guardians,

Education Outside the Classroom (EOTC) is widely recognized as having significant benefits for students. Schools throughout the world have developed opportunities for their students to be involved in new challenges and learning experiences that are very different to the classroom environment.

Renaissance College promotes this philosophy to support the holistic development of each individual student. The college has established a highly valued EOTC program supporting the IB continuum of learning, beginning in the PYP and extending through the MYP. EOTC is a fundamental aspect of the school curriculum and it is an expectation that all Year 7 students participate in this event.

The Year 7 residential camp will take place between **Tuesday 13 - Friday 16 November 2018**. During this time students will learn and develop key lifelong learning skills, such as collaboration, resilience and problem solving as part of the school's Positive Education Programme and in alignment with the IB Learner Profile attributes.
