About Renaissance College

Renaissance College Hong Kong (RCHK) is a co-educational independent school. RCHK was established in 2006 by the English Schools Foundation (ESF) to serve the needs of the local and international expatriate community in Hong Kong. It is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School and is accredited by Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) as well as the Council of International Schools (CIS).

Student Body

Renaissance College is home to 2093 students, ranging from Year 1 to Year 13. We have a diverse student body, with 50 nationalities and 24 languages represented on campus. There are more than 1108 students enrolled in the Secondary School, with 287 students currently pursuing the IB Diploma, IB Courses and IBCP Programmes. In the graduating class of 2019, there are 155 students.

School Calendar

The school year runs from mid-August to the end of June. There are two semesters comprising a total of 185 school days.

Semester 1 commences from August to mid January and Semester 2 commences from mid January to June.

Curriculum

Renaissance College is an authorized IB World School offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), the Diploma Programme (DP) and International Baccalaureate Career-Related Programme (IBCP). In Year 12 and 13, students undertake the full IB Diploma Programme, IB Courses or IBCP.

Students are NOT ranked at Renaissance College.

Formal student assessment is criterion-based. Students receive two full semester reports and one progress report each academic year.

Renaissance College follows the International Baccalaureate seven point grading scale.
7 = Excellent 6 = Very Good 5 = Good 4 = Satisfactory
3 = Mediocre 2 = Poor 1 = Very Poor
