### Financial Aid and Scholarship

### Curriculum

Renaissance College follows the International Baccalaureate seven point grading scale.



Renaissance College is an authorized IB World School offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), the Diploma Programme (DP) and the Career-Related Programme (IBCP). Year 12 and 13 students take the full IB Diploma Programme, IB Courses or IBCP.

Students are not ranked at Renaissance College. Formal student assessment is criterion-based. Students receive two full semester reports and one progress report each academic year.

Students are required to study the following MYP subjects from Year 7 to 11:

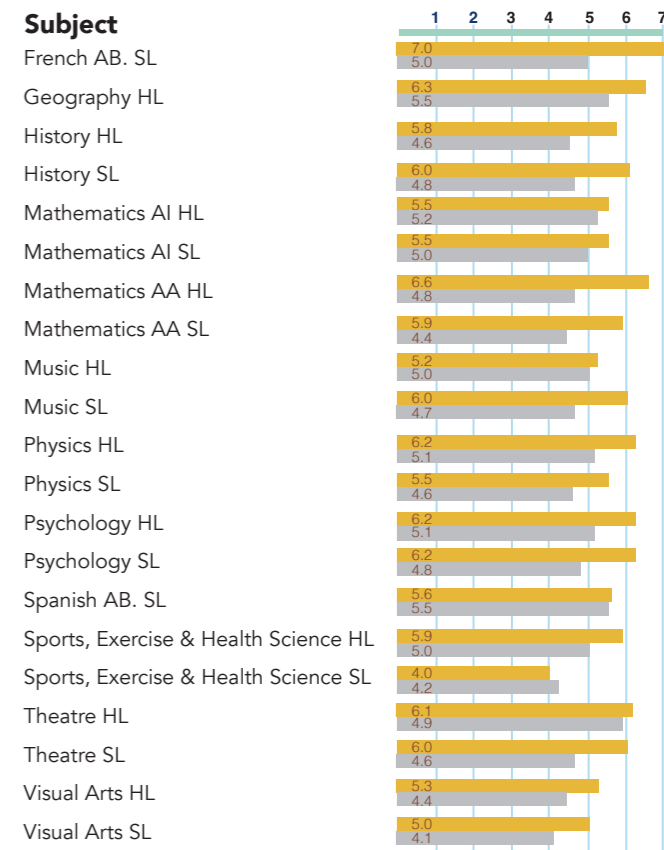
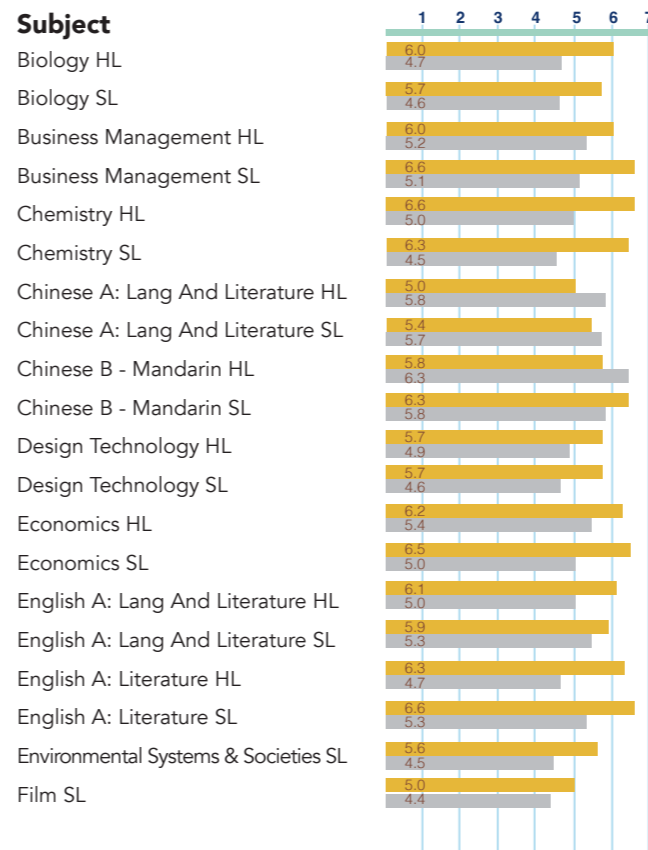

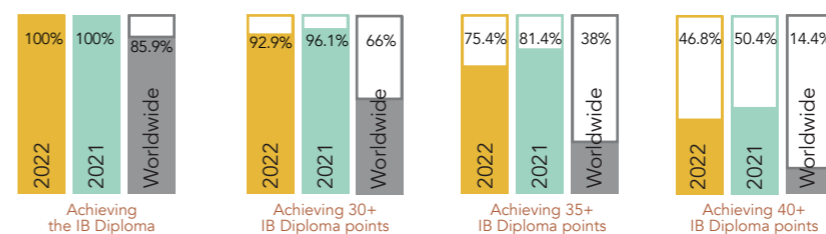
