Renaissance College follows the International Baccalaureate seven point grading scale.

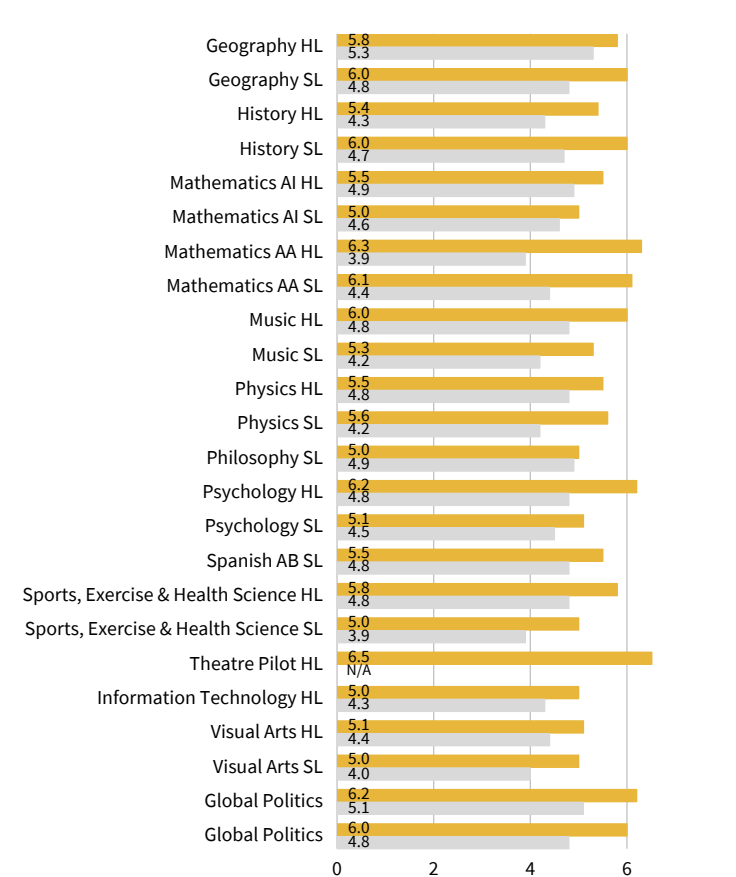
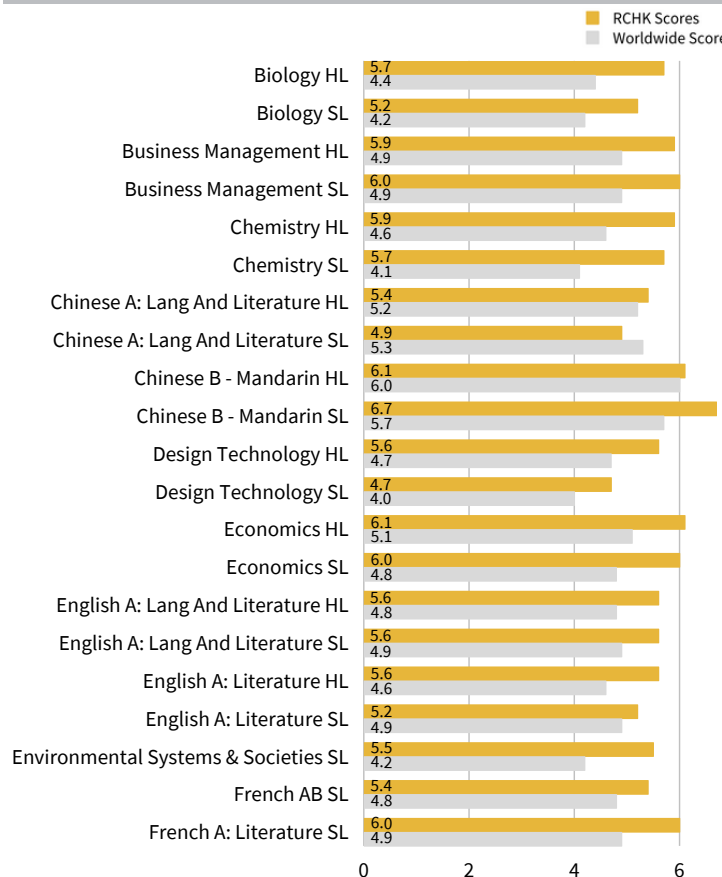

Year 12 and 13 students take the full IB Diploma Programme, IB Courses or IBCP. Students are not ranked at RCHK. Formal student assessment is criterion-based. Students receive two full semester reports and one progress report each academic year.

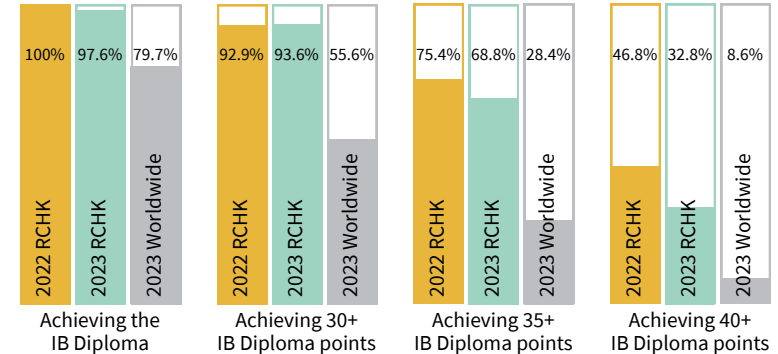
Students are required to study the following MYP subjects from Years 7 to 11. Additionally, students participate in Service as Action.
