General Information

Renaissance College Hong Kong (RCHK) is a world-class coeducational independent school and an IB World School. Located in the heart of Hong Kong's New Territories, the College was established as the flagship of the English Schools Foundation (ESF) in 2006 to serve the needs of the local and international expatriate community in Hong Kong.

Students are educated from Year one to university entrance (Year 13) on one campus, guided by an experienced international faculty. Our student body comprises 41 nationalities, with 21 languages represented on campus. English is the medium of instruction.

Apple Asia describes Renaissance College as a leading school in the region and technology is integrated college-wide throughout the curriculum.

Renaissance College encourages students to pursue knowledge, learn through service, and strive to build a better world through action.

Our Creativity, Action and Service (CAS) programme is integral to college life. Students participate in a myriad of artistic, musical, sporting, and service activities conducted on and off-campus.

The Renaissance College Scholarships and Financial Aid Programme provide pathways for motivated and talented secondary students who strive for excellence and are empowered to take progressive action.

The objectives of the program are to encourage and motivate our students to strive for academic excellence and balanced development, and to ensure students deserving of an excellent education are not constrained by financial considerations.





Full scholarships are attainable for students from Year 7 to Year 13, while the Financial Aid programme is offered on a needs basis throughout the academic year to all year levels, provided the College has places available.

Scholarship criteria are based on demonstrated academic ability, artistic and creative aptitude, sporting prowess and a commitment to service and leadership. Applicants should choose from one of five scholarships: academic, music, drama, visual arts and sports. Candidates are advised that the process is detailed and rigorous.

The next round of scholarship applications will begin on 8 January 2024 and the deadline for receipt of applications is 1 March 2024. The Scholarship Selection Test date is 16 March 2024. Applicants will be notified about the testing schedule by 8 March 2024. Shortlisted applicants will be notified about the interview schedule in April or May 2024. All applicants should be eligible to enter Renaissance College in August 2024.
